



Dear parent/carer,

I hope you received my letter last week about the changes to the uniform and PE kit last week. If you did not please contact your child's Head of Year and request a copy. We thought it would be helpful to send a reminder and some guidance about the items which are allowed as part of the policy. We want to avoid you buying incorrect or unnecessary items.

The essential uniform items that all pupils need:

- Plain black school trousers or a plain black school skirt (no denim, jogging bottoms, leather, combats, cargos, cords or shorts. Skirts must be knee length or longer).
- Plain white school shirt (not polo shirt)
- Plain unbranded black school shoes or plimsolls (no trainers)
- The school blazer or jumper (or both)
- The school tie
- School PE kit

Students can wear the additional items on the list below. These are optional and are not compulsory for any pupil.

- A warm, waterproof coat (no denim or leather and no hoodies)
- Headscarves, hijabs, durags or other forms of religious and cultural head coverings must be plain black, navy or white.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Plain black school trousers or a plain black school skirt.

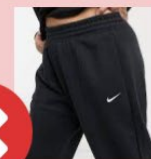


Children arriving incorrect trousers will received behaviour points and reflections for not being prepared. You may be called to bring them the correct uniform.



THESE ARE NOT ALLOWED.

No denim, jogging bottoms, leather, combats, cargo, cords or shorts. Skirts must be knee length or longer.

ACCEPTABLE SHOES

Only plain black leather shoes or plimsolls are allowed.
NO COLOUR. NO BRANDING.



THESE ARE NOT ALLOWED.

Children arriving in coloured or branded footwear will be asked to change into school daps for the day. They will receive a behaviour point for not being prepared. You may be called to bring them footwear.



The only brands which we allow are plain black Converse and Vans as they have no visible logos. Nike, Adidas, Skechers, Slazenger, Lonsdale or other any brands with visible logos will not be allowed.

ACCEPTABLE COATS

A warm, waterproof coat

HOODIES MAY BE CONFISCATED!

Pupils arriving in school in incorrect uniform will either be asked to change into their spare uniform or plain black plimsolls (daps) and will be issued with behavior points which may lead to reflections. Where we do not have appropriate uniform to loan or if uniform issues persist, we may contact you to arrange for the items to be brought to school or arrange for the pupil to go home to change into the correct uniform before returning to school.

With the environment and cost-of-living in mind, we also have a small stock of high quality pre-worn blazers at the school. We always welcome donations for this scheme so please consider donating your child's outgrown uniform or PE kit to us if you think it may be of use to someone else. Please speak to your child's Head of Year if you are interested in this.

A Welsh Government grant is available for those who need support to purchase essential school items. This can be claimed once per year per pupil. Your child's Head of Year is available to help any families who need additional support to access this grant.
